1 | Intro Activity

SUPPLIES

- (Optional) 1980s clothing and items

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY

- Inform the students about the theme night in advance so they can prepare costumes if they wish. Gather your own supplies, too.

LEADER TIP

- The word “radical” meant “cool” or “great” in the 1980s. In the Big Ideas for this series, it means relating to or affecting the fundamental nature of something; far-reaching or thorough; or having a root impact. Highlight both meanings as you kick off the “Radical” series.

INSTRUCTIONS

- a. Hold a 1980s theme night. Encourage the students to dress in '80s-style clothing, have an Etch A Sketch drawing contest, play a real-life version of Pac-Man, or create a trivia game about the decade. Be creative!
