## **APPETIZER: Celebrating our World Vision Partnership**

Our partnership began in 2011...

- About 2000 children sponsored in Mposa and Chamba, Malawi
- Additionally, we've provided \$100,000 to support both an Early Childhood Development Centre and Savings & Loans groups.
- In 2016 we began supporting World Vision's *Raw Hope* program. We've given \$350,000 to date.
- Cyclone Idai hit Malawi in March 2019 thankfully all Meeting House sponsored children are safe. Together, we contributed more than \$40,000 to the relief efforts ensuring families have access to clean water and other necessities at this time.

- I desire to see hope, healing, and reconciliation occur in places of brokenness


