### **HANGOUT** [Warming Up to the Topic – in one Large Group]

1. What stood out to you from Danielle's sermon? Share any lingering questions and reflections with the larger group.

2. Read **Luke 9:28-36**.
  - a. What verse or idea stands out to you?
  - b. Peter, James, and John are what we call "Jesus's huddle." Talk about the value of having a few close spiritual friends who you can journey through life with.
  - c. What do you think is the significance of Moses and Elijah appearing with Jesus?
  - d. The disciples in this passage experienced fatigue, confusion, and fear, even though they were with Jesus. What does this tell us about the reality of being a disciple?
  - e. When you hear God saying, "listen to Jesus," what teaching of his do you think of? What convicted you this Sunday?

3. Discuss your answers to a few or all of questions in the Dine In and Take out sections of the program as a huddle. Pray for one another.
