Finding Jesus in Each Other

Jeremiah 31:31-33; Jeremiah 31:34; Ezekiel 36:26; Isaiah 30:21
Hebrews 10:24-25

The New Covenant changes everything! We no longer follow a rule book. But we need each other all the more to help us listen to and live out the leading of the Spirit.

POSITIVE INSTRUCTIONS (Active expressions of love)

1. Love one another (John 13:34; 15:12-14; etc – over 15 times)
2. Be at peace with one another (Mark 9:50)
3. Serve / wash feet of one another (John 13:14; Galatians 5:13)
4. Be devoted to and honour one another (Romans 12:10)
5. Care for and bear the burdens of one another (1 Corinthians 12:25; Galatians 6:2)
6. Forgive one another (Ephesians 4:2, 32; Colossians 3:13)
7. Be kind and compassionate to one another (Ephesians 4:32)
8. Submit to one another (Ephesians 5:21, 1 Peter 5:5)
9. Consider one another better than yourselves (Philippians 2:3)
10. Encourage one another (1 Thessalonians 5:11)
11. Stir up [stimulate] one another to love and good works (Heb 10:24)
12. Confess your faults to and pray for one another (James 5:16)

NEGATIVE INSTRUCTIONS (How not to treat one another)

1. Do not lie to one another (Colossians 3:9)
2. Stop passing judgment on one another (Romans 14:13)
3. Stop biting and devouring one another (Galatians 5:15)
4. Let us not become conceited, provoking and envying one another (Galatians 5:26)
5. Do not slander one another (James 4:11)
6. Don't grumble against each other (James 5:9)

TAKE OUT: Love The One You're With

**Be devoted to one another in love.
Honor one another above yourselves.
~ The Apostle Paul (Romans 12:10)**

TODAY: Try to apply this one teaching of the Church.

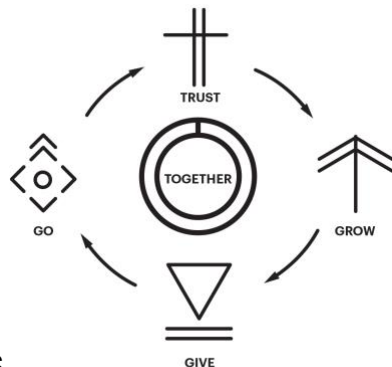
Home Church Questions

HANGOUT [Warming Up to the Topic – in one Large Group]

4. If you have time, repeat #3 above for the half-dozen negative instructions.

HUDDLE [Making It Personal and Praying Together – in Huddles]

5. Of the listed “one another” teachings, which do you need the most help with? Talk about it and pray for one another in light of this. Also brainstorm ways you might help one another grow in these areas beyond praying for one another.
