

### Home Church Questions

HANGOUT [Warming Up to the Topic – in one Large Group]

1. Read this quotation aloud and talk about how it connects to your experience from this week's message:  
"Every day we make choices. Then our choices make us. We have options. We make choices. Then we live the lingering effects, good and bad, of those decisions. 2. Read **Romans 12:10-18**. Then read it again using a different translation.
  - a. Identify the action verbs. Which of them do you find most challenging in your own life and/or in interactions with other people?
  - b. Now contrast that with which action verb you find easiest to do.
3. Take time as a Home Church to pray, listen to God, brainstorm together how you can start implementing some of these community care actions into your regular rhythm.
  - a. What kind of action steps as you do community together?
  - b. What's your plan for Community Care within your group?
  - c. How will you be available to care for others not part of your Jesus-centred community?
